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In accordance with the Order in re: Civil Contempt of R. Gregory Shepard (the “Contempt Order”),<sup>1</sup> Plaintiff United States of America filed a motion (the “Motion”)<sup>2</sup> seeking an award of attorneys’ fees and costs in the total amount of \$3,273.79. In his response to the Motion, Defendant R. Gregory Shepard states that he “agrees to pay the government’s fees in the amount of \$3,273.79.”<sup>3</sup> Therefore, for good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion<sup>2</sup> is GRANTED.
2. In accordance with the Contempt Order, Defendant R. Gregory Shepard shall pay the United States’ attorneys’ fees and costs in the total amount of \$3,273.79 in funds separate from property belonging to the Receiver or the receivership estate.


