At trial, the United States may seek to use all physical evidence, statements made by the defendant and others, police reports, phone records, electronic evidence (including body camera footage), documents, and photographs obtained during the investigation.

The United States reserves the right to introduce in its case-in-chief all tangible objects, physical, documentary, and electronic evidence, and all other evidence provided, made available, or identified in discovery.
