Payments to the company on the balance owed by the owner of the lens(es) will be paid directly by the operations and maintenance company, LTB, LLC, subracted from the rental fee payment as per the Operations and Maintenance Agreement. The purchaser retains all tax credits and other tax incentives for the total purchase price of the lens(es). Please consult with a qualified tax advisor or CPA on how this may apply to you.
